**Note:**

- *MPhil & PhD Candidates having **Irrelevant Academic Background** will be required to complete 6-9 Credit Hours additional **Deficiency Courses** as identified by the respective Departmental Admission Committee.*
- *Candidates having foreign certificates / degrees are required to submit HEC equivalence with minimum 17/18 years of education along with letter grades conversion to numerical marks / CGPA certificate from respective University for consideration of merit calculation. Applications without numerical rating shall be evaluated with minimum required criteria that is 60% for Annual and 3.0/4.0 for semester based degree.*
- *Foreign degree holders must provide equivalence certificate from IBCC & HEC with application form*

**Result Awaiting Applicants**

**BS Programs:**

**Local Boards/ Universities Candidates:**

The merit of result awaited candidates shall be determined on HSSC-Part-I marks. Candidates having foreign certificates should provide equivalence certificates from IBCC. In case the IBCC equivalence is delayed, merit shall be determined with minimum eligibility criteria of 2nd Div. (45 %).

The candidates have to deposit an Affidavit that they will have to submit their mark sheet before Mid-term examination.

Merit shall be determined on basis of HSSC Score, Entry Test and Interview.

### **International General Certificate of Secondary Education (IGCSE)/ A' Levels Candidates:**

Candidates applying for BS program while waiting for the announcement of their A' Level (Part 2) result will be admitted **provisionally** on the basis of A-1 (subsidiary level/clearing all 3 compulsory subjects). However, NDU will calculate their merit on basis of the (official) grade Sheet of A-1 level (as per numerical marks determined by IBCC). **IBCC equivalence of O' levels** must be provided in any case.

Admitted Candidates shall be required to submit IBCC equivalence for A' levels within 4 weeks after commencement of classes failing which their provisional admission will be cancelled.

- Conduct – Evening / Weekend Program
- Eligibility criteria - 16 years Education from HEC Recognized Institution

### **MPhil (Evening & Weekends) and PhD Programs (Evening):**

- All final semester, result awaiting applicants applying for MPhil degree progms may be accommodated in line with BS applicants as per fol categories:
  - (a) NDU Graduating Students:** NDU Exam Branch to provide 7<sup>th</sup> sem result on which their merit will be calculated.
  - (b) Outside NDU Graduating Students:** Applicants to provide respective University's Exam Branch 7<sup>th</sup> sem result on which their merit will be calculated.
- MS/MPhil & PhD candidates are required to submit their official transcript and relevant degree with admission form.
- PhD candidates must submit their HEC attested relevant terminal degree (MS/MPhil orequivalent) with admission form.
