Passing marks in GAT (G) are 60% whereas, passing marks in-interview are 50%). Applicants shall be required to present their Research Proposal & statement of purpose before panel.</p> <p>*HAT-3 category (Social Sciences) will be accepted for GPP, IR, PCS, SS, ECO & FSS.
